



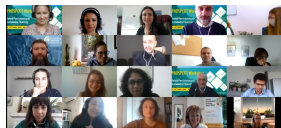

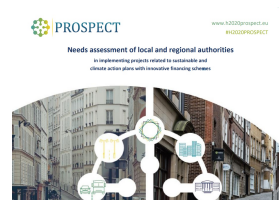
Behind the Scenes: Virtual Peer Learning on Sustainable Financing
